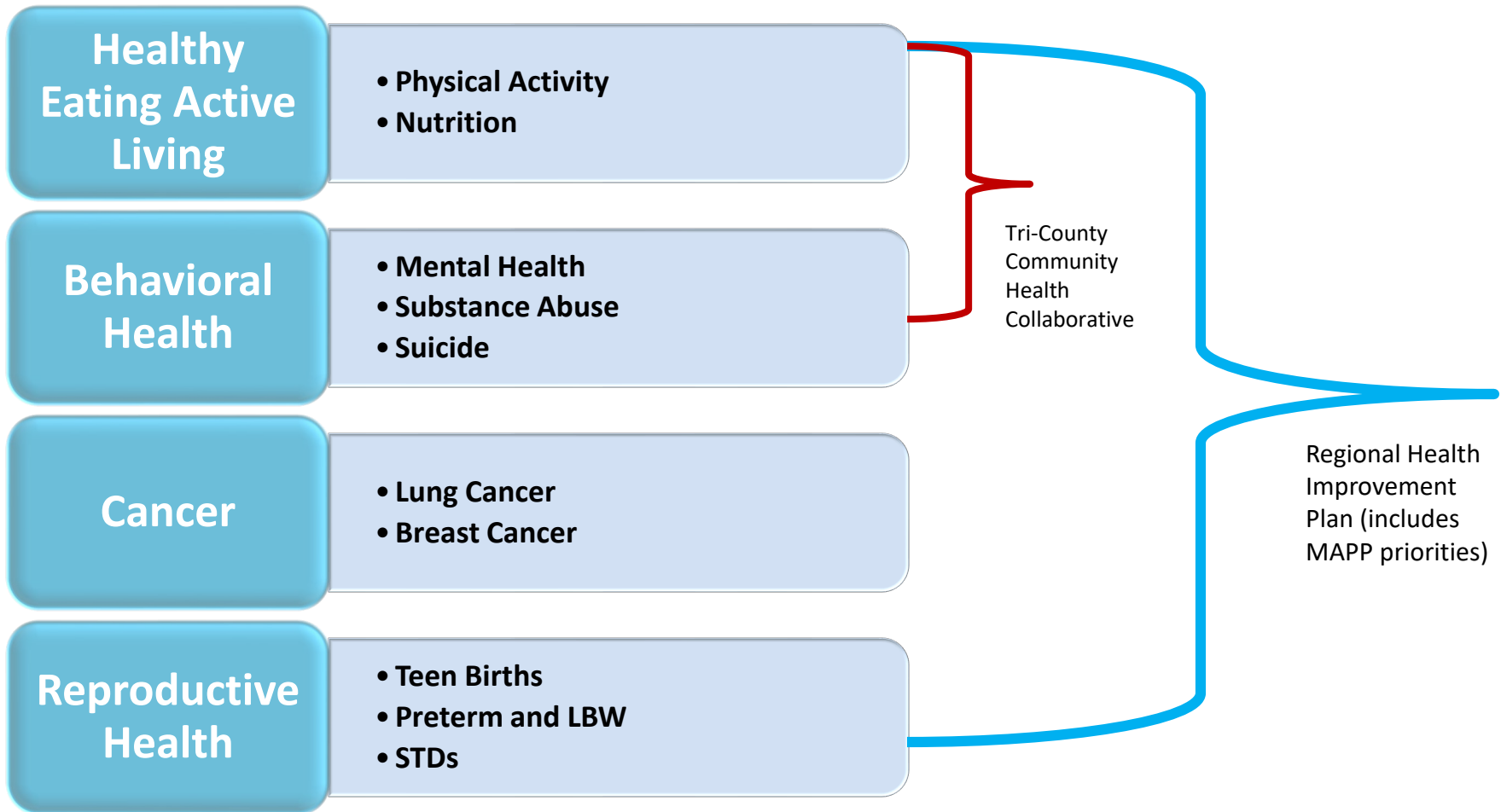

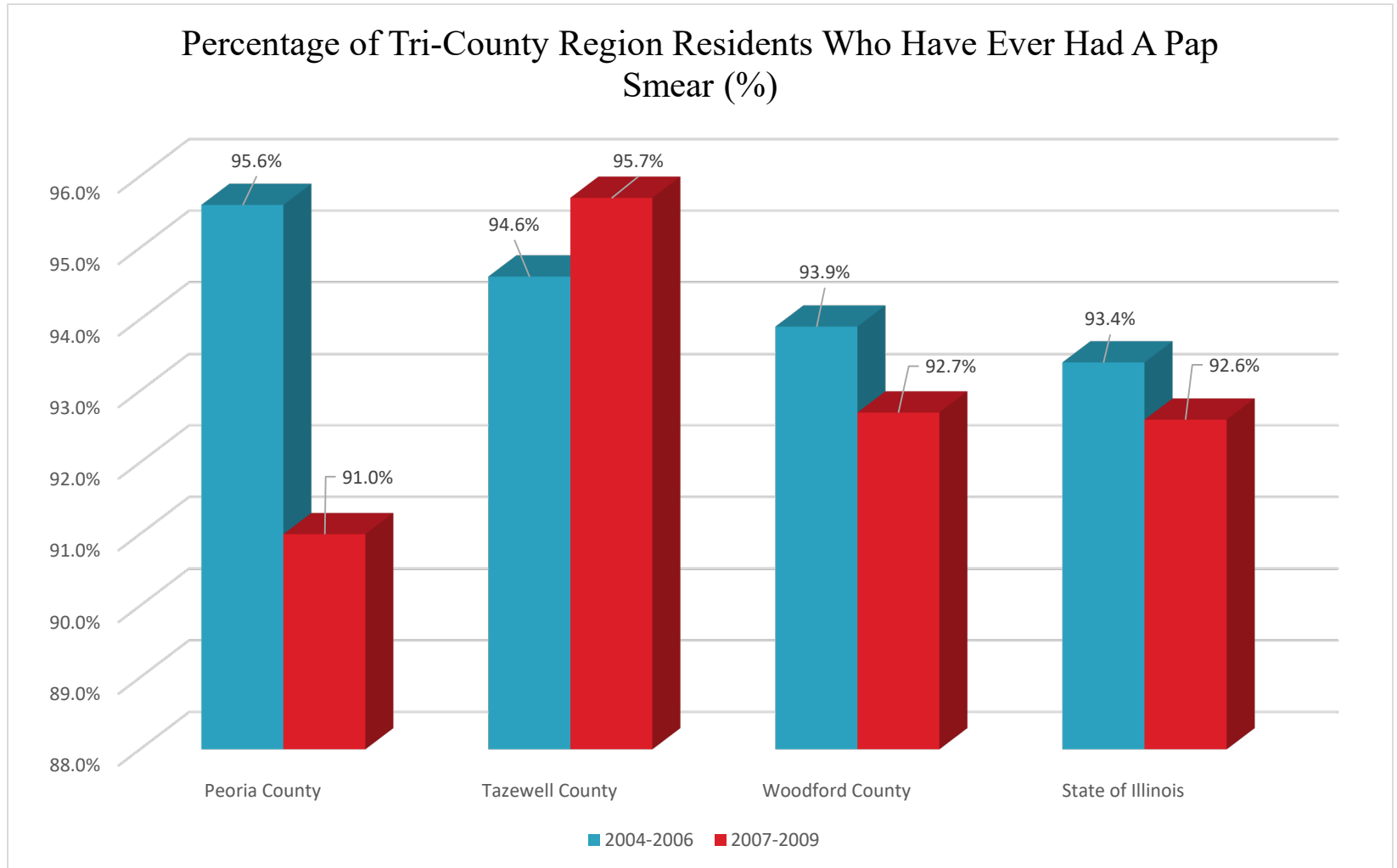

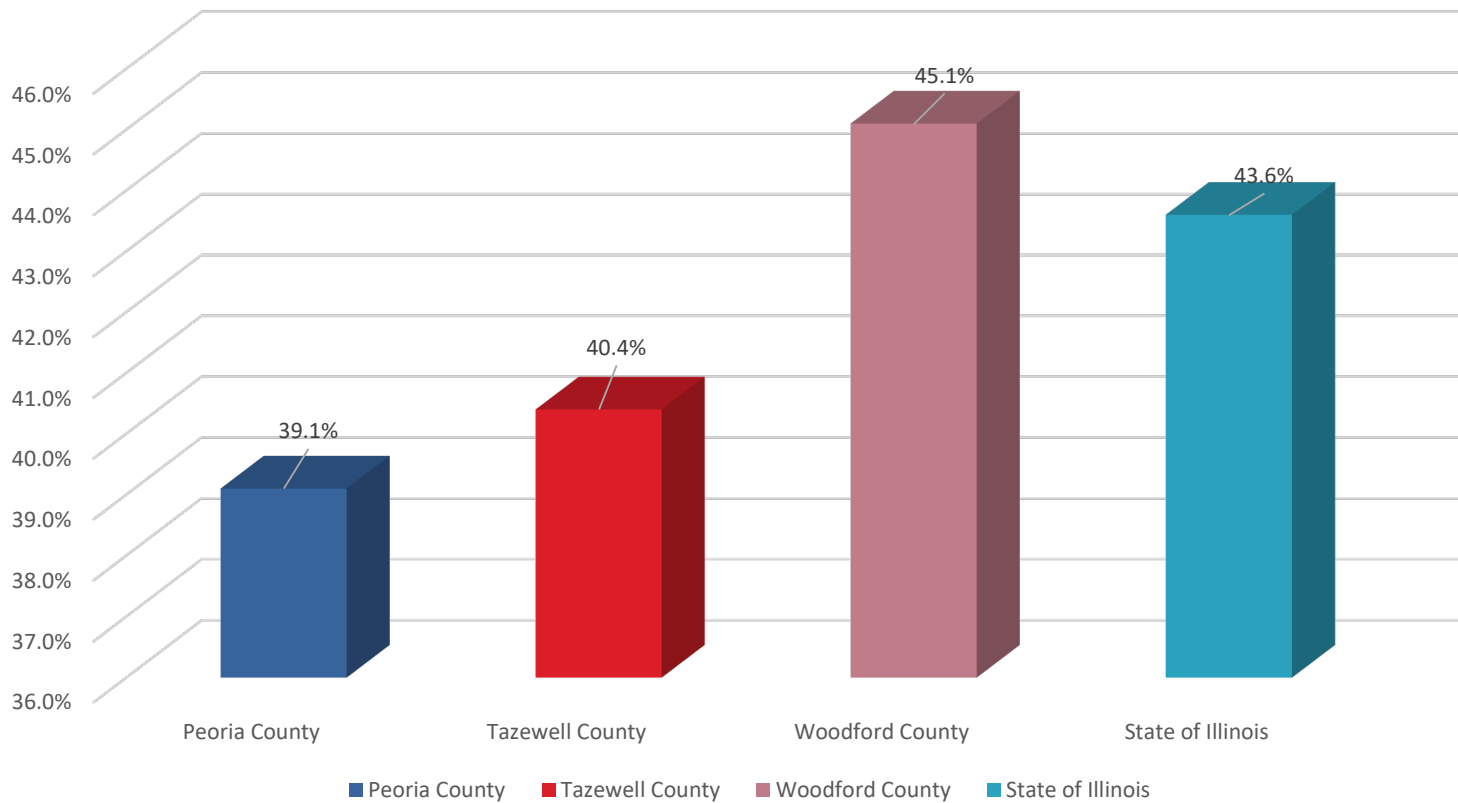

Pap Smear Percentages for Tri-County, by county



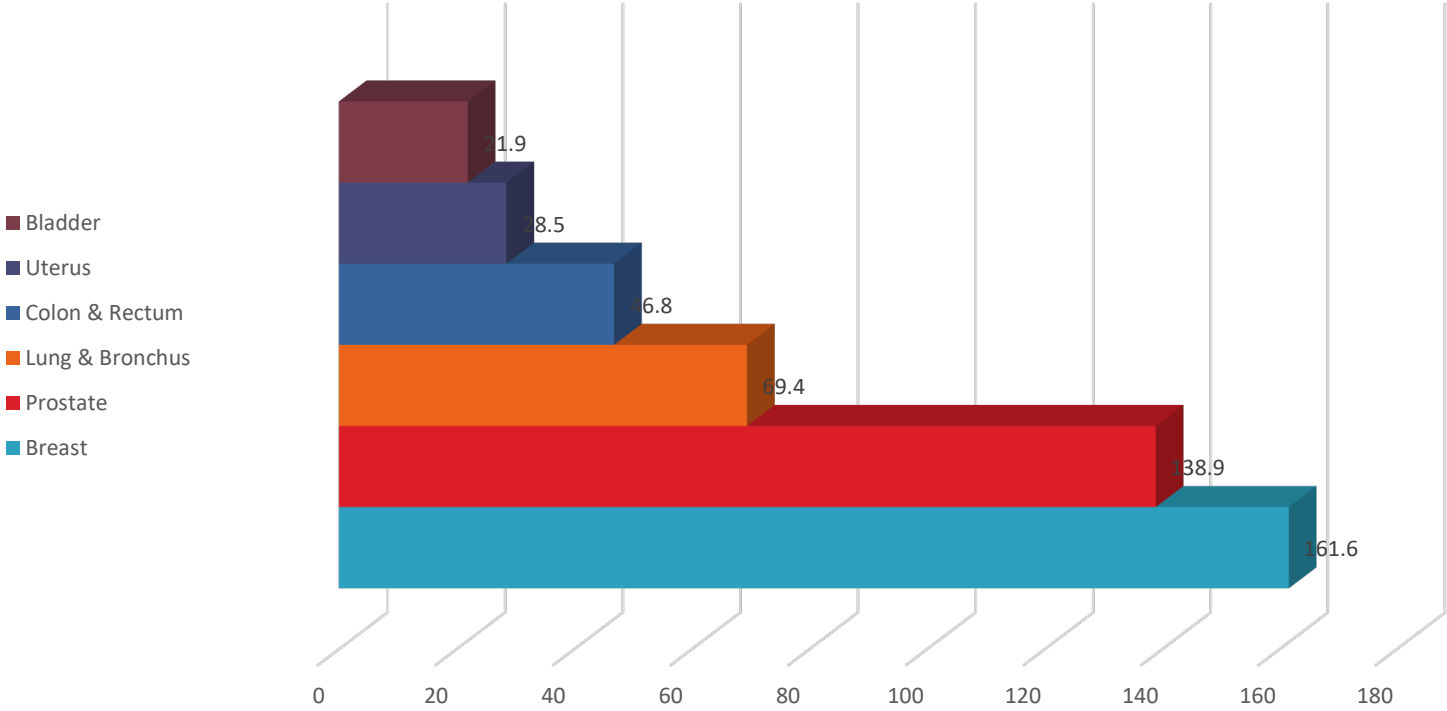
Greater than One Year Since Last Mammogram for Tri-County Residents, by county in 2009

Greater than One Year Since Last Mammogram by Tri-County Region Residents (%)



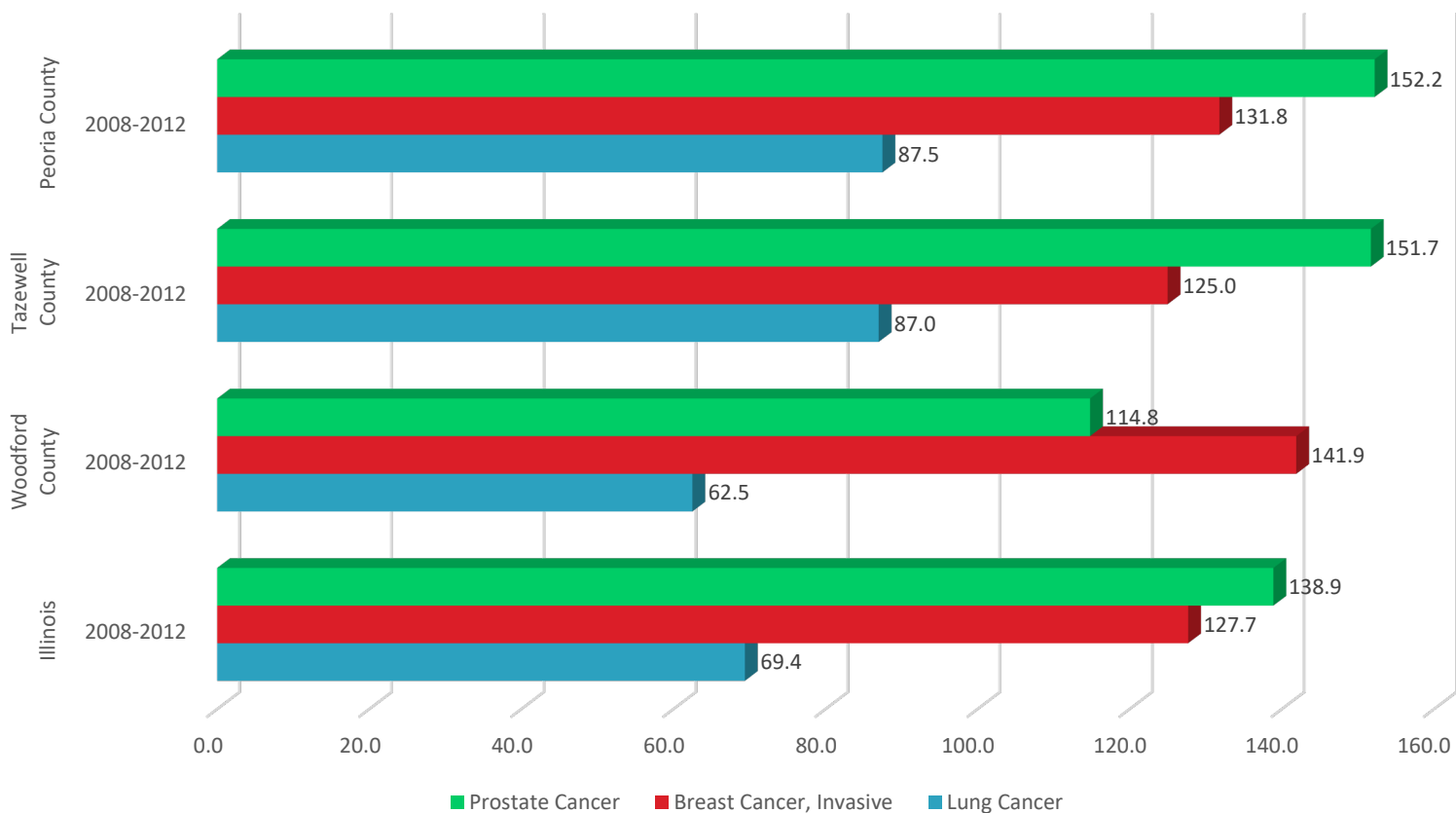
Top 6 Cancers by Treatment for State of Illinois 2008-2012

Top Three Prevelent Cancers per 100,000 cases in Five-Year Average for Tri-County 2008-2012

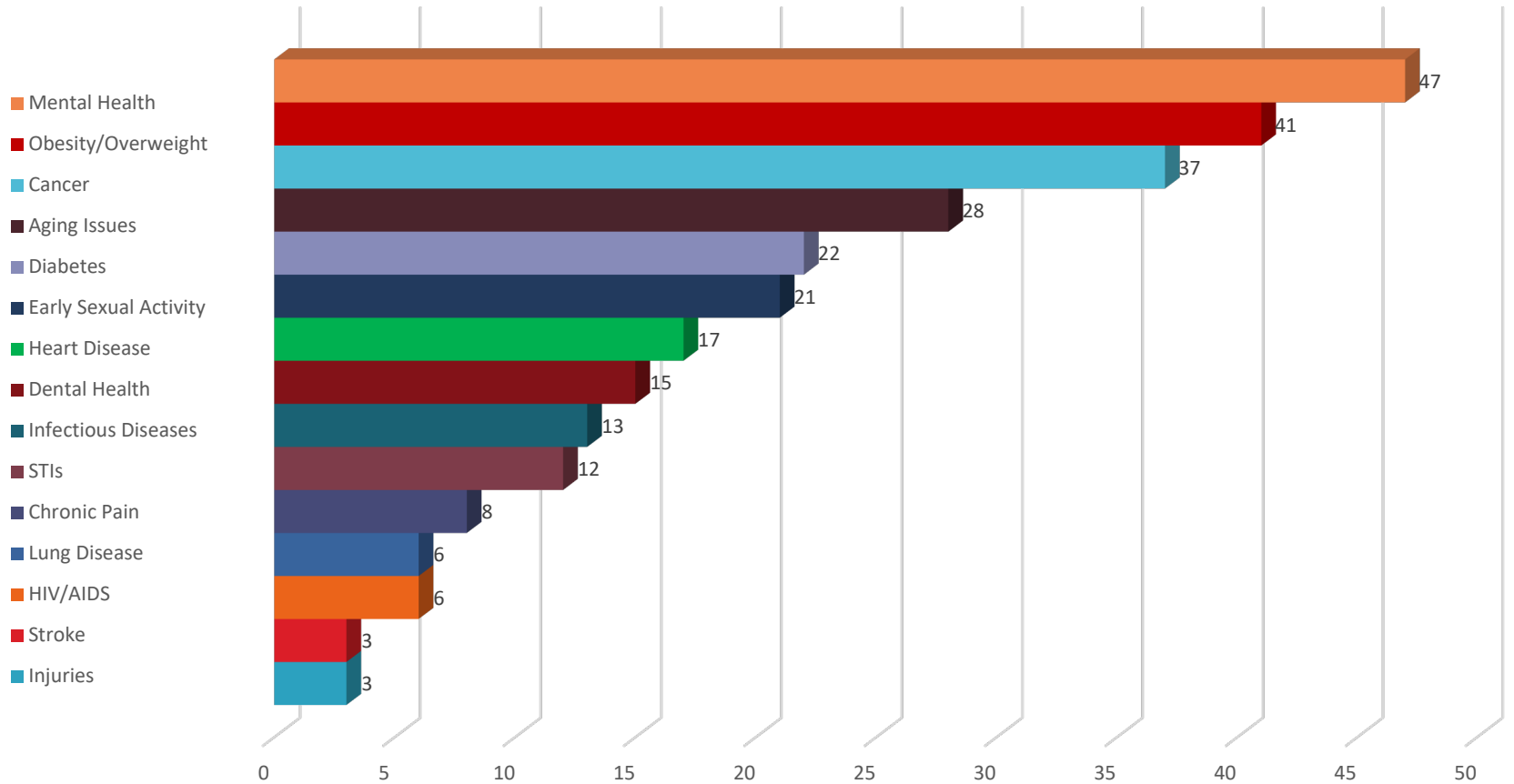

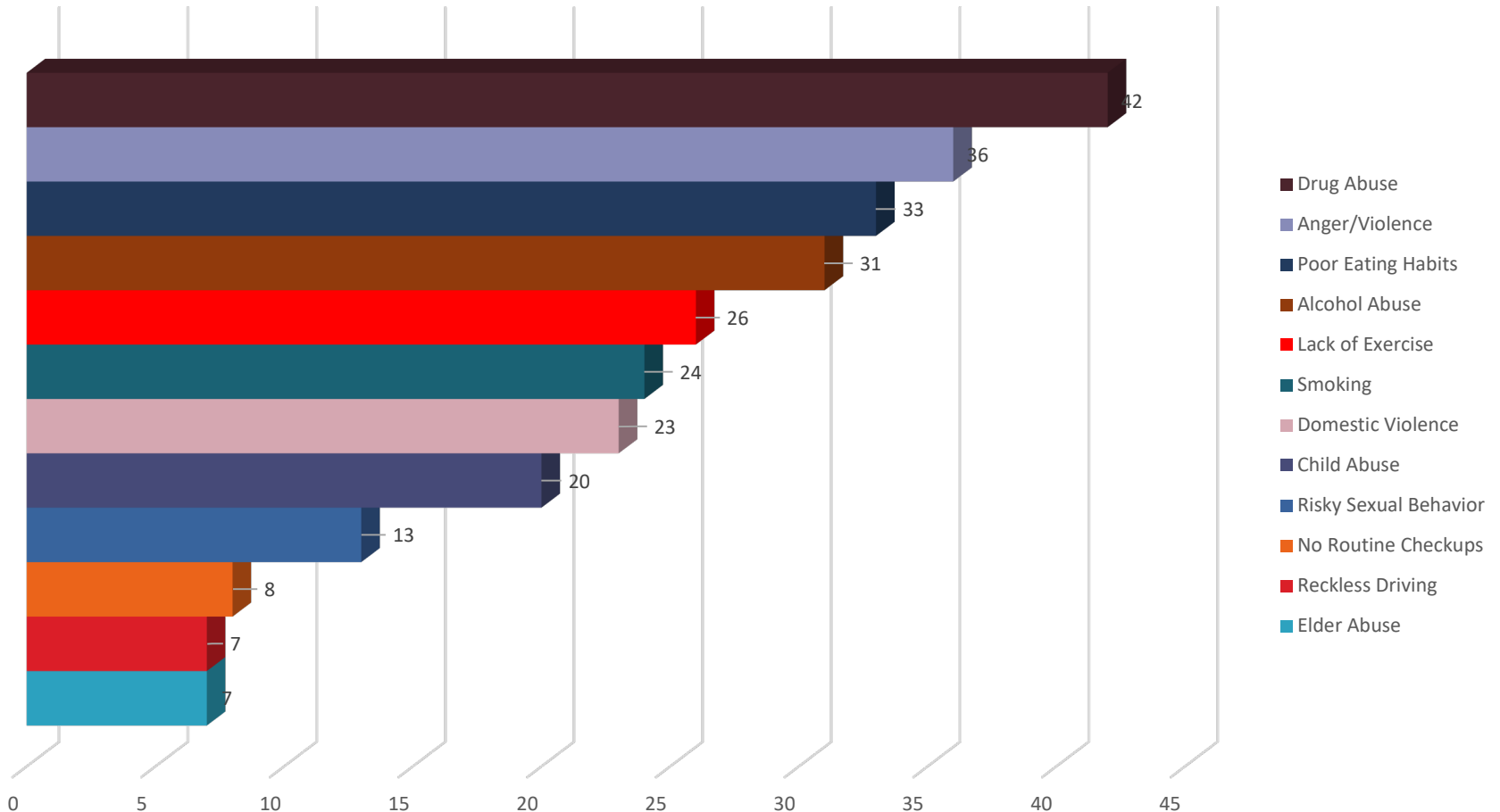
General Population Perception of Health Issues

in Tri-County Region (%)



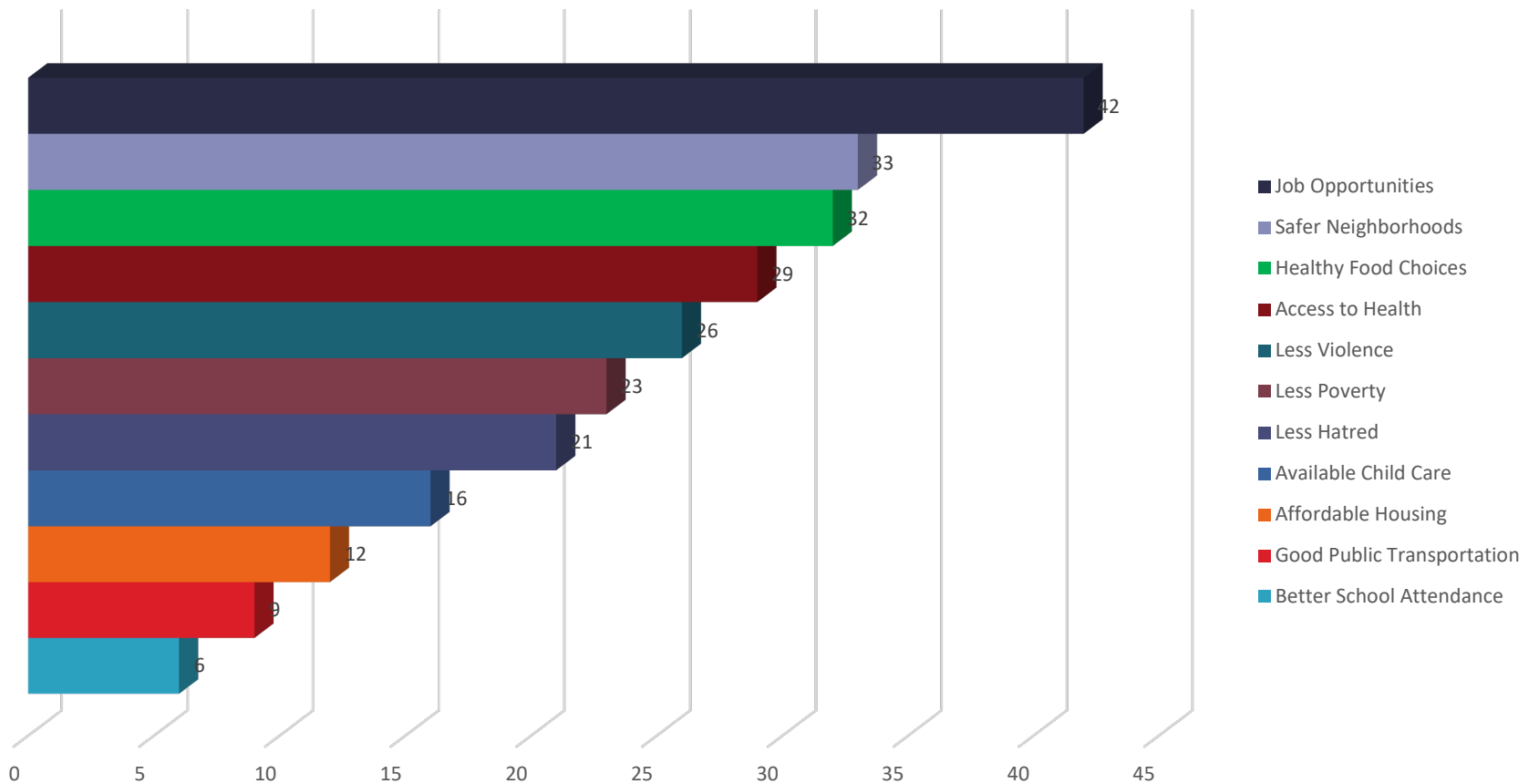
Perceptions of Unhealthy Behaviors

Tri-County Region Percentages for Most Important Perceived Unhealthy Behaviors in the Community (%)

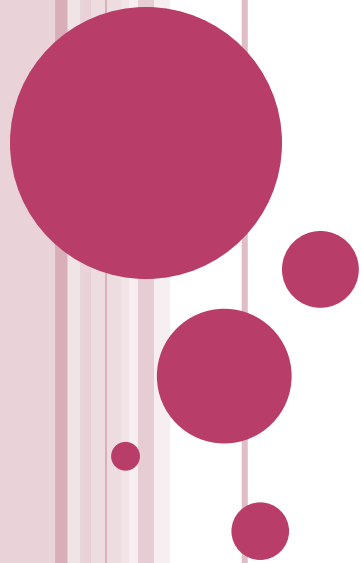


Most Important Perceived Factors that Impact Quality of Life
